This year again we have taken great efforts to mold our class 10 students to face the board examination which begins on February 17th. We have done multiple assessments, periodic tests, weekly assessments, 2 term exams, and planned 3 model examinations to equip them for the CBSE Board examination. We are starting night classes from the last week of December till the end of Board exams. Let God grace our children with blessings. We, the Management, Staff and students wish them good luck for their future endeavors.

Talent Search Examination aims to gain a better grasp of their course work, enhance their academic abilities & sharpen their analytical and problem- solving skills. In the State level talent search examination Namdev T of class 1, Vaishnavi Praveen of class 2, Adhithyan PR and Saketh Narayan of class 3 received Silver Medal. Sreerudra.N of class 1, Arjun.R, Ved Krishna V and Aarav Siva of class 2, Parvathi.M, Aarav P and Aparna R nair of class 3, Adharv RK, Aarush.P and Mithreya T.S of class 4, Dhananjay PK and Ishaan KS of class 6, Adwaith Krishna.P of class 8, Sarang TS of class 9 received Bronze medal.

We conduct quiz competition every week for classes I & 2 . Winners of each week are crowned as the 'Stars of the week '. The Megastars are Vedha Vimal of class 2 (category 1), Aparna R Nair of class 3 (cat 2). They have shown excellent performance throughout the academic year. Students of classes 3 to 9 are

encouraged to read newspaper during the reading mission period and quiz competitions are held fortnightly to make our students more inquisitive about the world around them. This makes our children to be competent to face all the competitive examinations. Under category 3 Suryan.A, Madhavi O.N of class 8, Krithi Murali, Viswajith.v, Sarang T.S, & Devikha of class 9 performed well.

Apart from preparing children to qualify for purely academic demands special efforts are being made continuously in co-curricular activities also. We all know that creativity involves breaking out established pattern in order to look at things in a different way.

Our School has always taken initiatives to get the best talent in the sports arena. Students actively participated in the Scout and Guide camp held in the month of July under the guidance of Shri. Shivakumar Jaggu and Smt. Ajitha gaining training in leadership, discipline teamwork, self-reliance and civic responsibility.
